## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

### THE CANCER CARE FOUNDATION OF NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR

(Cancer Care Foundation) is accepting proposals for the Installation of two commissioned artwork pieces for the Cancer Centre Western Region located at the new Western Memorial Regional Hospital.

The Cancer Care Foundation is looking to commission **two pieces of artwork** that represent the culture, community and heritage of Western Newfoundland and we encourage submissions from local indigenous artists. Please note that artwork can be painting, photography, sculpture, beading etc. as long as it fits the dimensions outlined below.

### SIZE OF REQUIRED PIECES:

#1: 1000mm (W) x 1220mm (H)

#2: 3650mm (W) x 835 mm (H)

**FINAL DELIVERY DATE:** May 27, 2024

The Cancer Care Foundation is aiming to choose the successful artist(s) by mid-March.

### THE SUBMITTED PROPOSAL MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDE- LINES TO BE CONSIDERED:

- The primary color used in the piece cannot be black.
- Content should be reflective of Western Newfoundland scenery, culture, experiences etc.
- The Cancer Care Foundation will retain the rights to the commission pieces.
- Any materials that cannot be washed (ie. Fabric, beading etc.) must be encased for hanging or display by the artist.
- Sculpture submissions must have the ability to be secured to the wall and be mindful of public safety concerns (ie. Sharp edges).

### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- A written description of the proposed artwork including but not limited to; the medium, content description, installation method and any necessary maintenance required.
- A resume or biography of the artist, including a selected portfolio of past and present works.
- A fee proposal.



### CONTACT ONSITE VISIT REGISTRATION:

Complete proposals can be submitted either electronically by email or by mail directly to the address below.

We will be facilitating one (1) onsite viewing visit time to see the space for each piece in the Cancer Centre. Interested artists who wish to register for this site visit must reach out by email to **info@cancercarefoundation.nl.ca** by February 21st. The onsite visit will be scheduled for the week of February 26th. Please know, the site visit is optional and not required to submit a proposal.
